The 2013 vintage has been dubbed the 'Tale of Two Harvests' due to the split in harvest dates based on the rain event that occurred in mid-September. By paying close attention to each vineyard block's development, we picked according to flavor and ripeness and enjoyed the benefits of both the pre and post rain 'harvests'!

Jeffrey's Block is our oldest block, and is named after the eldest son of the vineyard's owners. Jeffrey's block is a south and slightly east facing block with a gradual slope and volcanic clay-based Jory and Nekia soils.

Tasting Notes

Medium brick red in color, with a bright and lifted nose of cranberry, orange peel, and dried herbs. The palate is light-footed and soft, with a sweet burst of red fruit on the front end.
