2013 WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR



The 2013 vintage has been dubbed the 'Tale of Two Harvests' due to the split in harvest dates based on the rain event that occurred in mid-September. By paying close attention to each vineyard block's development, we picked according to flavor and ripeness and enjoyed the benefits of both the pre and post rain 'harvests'!

Our Willamette Valley Pinot Noir was developed to bring balance and consistency to our portfolio. The 2013 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir combines the spice, minerality, and structure of our Eola-Amity Hills Estate with the fruit-driven characteristics of lower elevation Pinot Noir.

Tasting Notes

Medium garnet red in color. A spicy and earthy nose, with lifted notes of incense, pine tips, and holiday baking spice. Black cherry aromas interweave with earthy forest floor tones to add complexity and depth to the bouquet. The palate is vibrant and mouth-filling, with punchy acid and a firm structure. Sweet holiday spice characters linger on the finish.
