VINTAGE

The 2017 vintage was cool and long, and the wines are representative of the classic Oregon style.

TASTING NOTES & ACCOLADES

Medium ruby red in color. The nose is elegantly layered and rich, with alluring notes of dark fruit, five-spice, earthy forest floor, and hints of graphite. The palate is warm with focused tannins, with tension that speaks to its place of origin. The finish is vibrant with notes of tobacco spice.

CASE PRODUCTION: 925

FERMENTATION STYLE: 5% whole cluster fermentation, individual small lot, open top fermenetations. Majority native yeast with a smidge of cultured yeast.

CAP MANAGEMENT: manual punch downs and pump overs. BARREL PROGRAM: 28% New French oak. Aged 17 months.
