The 2013 vintage has been dubbed the "Tale of Two Harvests" due to the split in harvest dates based on the rain event that occurred in mid-September. By paying close attention to each vineyard block's development, we picked according to flavor and enjoyed the benefits of both the pre and post rain "harvests"!

Our 2013 Pinot Blanc is our inaugural release, and we are excited to bring this crisp and refreshing wine to you! David's Cuvée is named after the youngest light-haired son of our Estate's owners. Pinot Blanc is a white variant of Pinot Noir, and although limited in Oregon, is widely planted in Alsace and other cool regions of Europe. We planted David's block in 2010, knowing that our vineyard was an ideal fit for the grape.

Tasting Notes

Brilliant straw yellow, with delicate pear, lemon curd, and melon on the nose. Hints of beeswax and biscuit linger in the background and add a pleasant savory layer to the aromatics. The palate is dry and racy, exhibiting tart lemon flavors and a clean and focused finish.
