



2010 JEFFREY'S BLOCK



The 2010 Oregon vintage was marked by a late spring and a cool summer. As a result, our 2010 wines are overall lighter and more restrained than their 2008 and 2009 predecessors. We encourage you to embrace vintage variation and enjoy the minerality and delicacy of our 2010 Pinot Noirs.

Jeffrey's block is a south and slightly east facing block with a gradual slope and volcanic clay based Jory and Nekia soils. Jeffrey's Block is also our oldest block, and is named after the eldest son of the vineyard's owners.

Tasting Notes

Clear and bright brick red, with a nose showing marked minerality and delicate aromas. The aromas of faint strawberry, pie dough and biscuit play against mineral notes of wet concrete and chalk. The palate is sweet and soft, light bodied and agile. Overall, the palate is subtle and finished quick and clean.
