



2010 ESTATE PINOT NOIR



The 2010 Oregon vintage was marked by a late spring and a cool summer. As a result, our 2010 wines are overall lighter and more restrained than their 2008 and 2009 predecessors. We encourage you to embrace vintage variation and enjoy the minerality and delicacy of our 2010 Pinot Noirs.

Our small 15 acre Estate Vineyard has 3 different soil types, 4 distinct slope exposures, and ranges from 675 ft to 820 ft in elevation. Our Estate Pinot Noir is an elegant blend of grapes from each estate block, bearing the distinctive characteristics of our entire vineyard.

Tasting Notes

Brick red with a mahogany tinge. A very delicate nose of marmalade, pea pod, crushed leaves, olive, and tobacco. The palate is lean and subtle with evident minerality and light fruit notes while showing spirited acidity and chalky tannins.
